Artists Resale Right Droit De Droit de suite (French for "right to follow") is a right granted to artists or their heirs, in some jurisdictions, to receive a fee on the resale of their works of art. This should be contrasted with policies such as the American first-sale doctrine, where artists do not have the right to control or profit from subsequent sales. Droit de suite - Wikipedia THE Artist's Resale Right (ARR), which is also referred to as the "Droit de suite", originated in France and allows an artist to claim royalties for the resale of his or her art. provides artists with an opportunity to benefit from the increased value of their works over time by granting them a percentage of the proceeds from the resale of their original works of art. The royalty originated in France in the 1920s and is in general practice throughout Europe, but is not part of current United States copyright law. Resale Royalty Right | U.S. Copyright Office In France, where droit de suite has been recognized since 1920, the percentage due to the artist or the artist's heirs from any resale is calculated on a sliding scale based on value of the artwork. applies in the European Economic Area to living artists and artists who have died in the last 70 years (currently artists who died after 1949). Member States may provide for the optional or compulsory collective management by collecting societies [Art. 6 (2)]. In prescribed situations, it provides an artist with a right to receive a royalty based on the price obtained for the resale of an original work of art, subsequent to the first transfer by the artist. Artist's resale right Resale right will be managed by collecting societies; individual artists will not be able to request payments directly. This means that the seller/auction house will be required to pay all royalties to a collecting society who will then distribute them to the artists.
